Your Opportunity:

We have an exciting opportunity for an Electromyography Technician to join the Alberta Neurologic Centre. As part of our team, the EMG technician will be responsible for assisting physicians and clinicians in clinic. The technician will conduct and record Nerve Conduction/EMG Studies under the supervision of a physician. The technician will perform systematic evaluations by performing duties such as, locating and stimulating nerves, analyzing recordings, measuring numerical data, describing abnormal manifestations, and forwarding calculations to the physician.

The technician reviews and analyzes patients' medical history to determine appropriate neurodiagnostic and ultrasound procedures, along with interviewing patients and/or family members to obtain additional information. The technician will perform all assigned duties in strict compliance with established policies, procedures, and protocols, and always works to ensure patient safety, comfort, and privacy.

Duties and Tasks:

Under general physician supervision, the EMG technician will perform Nerve Conduction Studies in the clinic. They will assist with electromyography examinations and are responsible for explaining the NCS test procedure to the patient to obtain full cooperation necessary for a complete examination. The technician will perform systematic evaluations related to nerve, neuromuscular junction, and muscle disorders. This involves invasive needle EMG exams, as well as routine and advanced NCS. The technician will perform preventative maintenance on equipment by performing duties such as, calibrating and cleaning equipment to ensure accurate results recorded. The technician will be responsible for keeping equipment and patient procedure rooms in clean, operating condition and fully stocked with required supplies. The technician may also assist with referral triaging. Travelling may be required to remote clinics (ex. Stanton Hospital, Northwest Territories).

Who you are:

- Applications must have graduated from a formal electrophysiology program, or equivalent training.
- Applicants must have successfully completed the Board of Registration of Electromyography Technologist of Canada (BRETTC) examination.
- An up-to-date CPR certification is also required.
- A growing health professional with a minimum of one to three years' experience
- An eager learner who has experience with EMRs, Netcare, Connectcare and health technology but who more importantly brings an enthusiasm to acquire these skills.
- An excellent communicator who has a focus on utilizing both written and oral communication skills both with the team and patients.
